- III. Rewrite each sentence to express the opposite meaning by changing the subjects to direct objects and the direct objects to subjects. Make other changes as necessary. There are 4 Latin sentences to rewrite as directed. Be careful with singular and plural. Changing the subject from singular to plural and vice versa means that you will have to change the verb ending, too, so that a plural subject has a plural verb; a singular subject has a singular verb.
- IV. Fill in the blanks in this story with words chosen from the list below. Do not use any word more than once.
